HISTORY

Hôtel Royal's history is intrinsically tied to the evian® natural mineral water spring and the concept of the thermal spa, which has drawn holidaymakers mindful of their health and well-being to Evian since the early 20th century.

Built in honour of King Edward VII of England, Hôtel Royal was inaugurated in 1909.

The monarch, who was to be one of its first guests, died in 1910 without having fulfilled his promise to visit the stunning establishment.

Over the course of its history, Hôtel Royal has welcomed a host of personalities, including

the Queen Mother of England, the poet and novelist Anna de Noailles, Igor Stravinsky, Mstislav Rostropovitch, Sacha Guitry, Georges Brassens, Greta Garbo, as well as Ray Charles, Barbara Hendricks, Phil Collins, Kylie Minogue, Jacques Dutronc, Hugh Grant, Isabelle Adjani, Claudia Cardinale, numerous heads of state, princes from Europe and the Middle East, ambassadors and more... Famous guests have stayed at this iconic Palace hotel, which epitomises French-style luxury and is a unique place of revitalisation.



AN ARCHITECTURAL GEM *in an idyllic setting*

In 2015, the hotel was completely renovated by head architect of historic monuments François Chatillon and interior designer François Champsaur, who restored this superb building to all its splendour. They did a remarkable job, enhancing the heritage elements such as the listed frescoes by Gustave Louis Jaulmes and Adrien Karbowsky, combining them with subtle contemporary touches.

Unique pieces of art and limited editions from talented designers such as Olivier Gagnère, Pierre Colin and Cécile Charroy adorn the bookshelves in the guest rooms and the Grand Salon. The Italian artist Marco del Re was also commissioned to produce a monumental contemporary fresco that adorns the ceiling of the restaurant La Véranda.

The French art of living is present throughout, in the hotel lobby and restaurants, at evian®SPA or in the bar and in its 150 rooms and suites. The hotel's grandeur is also to be found in the details: frescoes with their enchanting floral patterns, furniture made from precious wood, fine materials, exquisite fabrics, the collection of modern and contemporary art as well as flower arrangements by the Palace hotel's florists. Each year, the garden-level conference centre with a vast lawned terrace, lake views and 13 meetings rooms ranging in size from 25 to 300m², is the venue for conferences and events with global reach, as was the case in 2003 with the G8 Summit and again for a second time in 2026, during the G7 Summit.

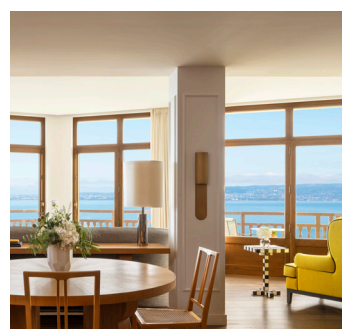
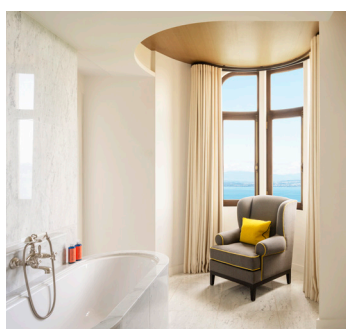
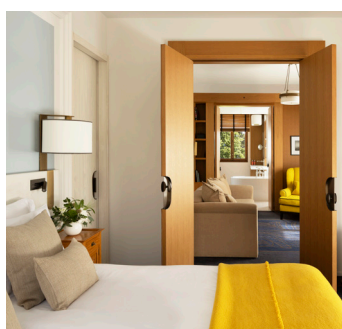
ROOMS AND SUITES *in a magnificent natural setting*

Hôtel Royal has 150 rooms, including 32 suites and junior suites. The architectural layout showcases uninterrupted views of the lake, with 120 enjoying views of Lake Geneva. The rooms are a haven on tranquillity, bathed in gentle light and enveloped in soothing quiet, while the bathrooms are illuminated by natural daylight.

With its 32 suites and junior suites, Hôtel Royal offers its guests expansive spaces.

Seven of them are located on the 6th and top floor and can be booked for exclusive use and secured for guests looking for privacy and discretion. All these suites interconnect to create an overall surface area of 640m², excluding the terraces.

The Palace hotel's most exclusive suites are the Royal Suite, 207m² with 60m² of terraces and the Edward VII Suite, 165m² and 20m² of terraces.





FOOD & DRINK EXCELLENCE

Dining plays a key role at Hôtel Royal.

The Michelin-star "Les Fresques" is headed by Chef Yohan Fatela, who has been at Hôtel Royal since March 2026. Upon his arrival, Yohan managed the dining experiences for the 200 Years Young evian® brand celebration, as well as for Heads of State during the 2026 G7 Summit.

At Les Fresques, Yohan Fatela serves contemporary cuisine rooted in French tradition. The Chef is committed to sourcing nearby and ensuring traceability, working not only with local producers but also with the head gardener who assists him in growing his 3,000m² kitchen garden. A sustainable approach which was rewarded with a 3-macaron badge from Ecotable.

The restaurant's name "Les Fresques" is in reference to the pictorial works by Gustave Louis Jaulmes and Adrien Karbowsky that adorn the restaurant's ceiling.

Chef Yohan Fatela is also at the helm of the Hôtel Royal's two other restaurants: "La Véranda" and "L'Oliveiraie". At "La Véranda", the menu showcases diverse and delicious cuisine that favours fresh ingredients. Every Sunday, the restaurant becomes a favourite spot for the Royal Brunch which can be enjoyed with family and friends overlooking the stunning grounds and lake.

"L'Oliveiraie" is a summertime restaurant that nestles under the pine and olive trees by the outdoor pool.

This additional dining option adds to the holiday feel that emanates from the atmosphere at Hôtel Royal.

With an interest on changing tastes and trends, Head Sommelier Loïc Chavasse-Frette is dedicated to improving his wine cellar by introducing his fine wine loving clients to some of the gems from Haute-Savoie vineyards. He has also crafted a tea menu, with the drinks served in a bottle, which appeals to a clientele looking for the taste without the inebriation. Recently, tea has become a gastronomic beverage at "Les Fresques" and provides a superb alternative for food and drink pairings.

The Bar Director Davide Trupia seeks to dazzle his epicurean guests with his cocktail and mocktail creations.

And finally, those involved in the world of taste at Hôtel Royal live out their passion by creating their own products. These include honey, a vintage Negroni and a wine blend in partnership with a local wine grower.





evian®SPA

Water at the heart of the wellness experience

Inaugurated in 2024, Hôtel Royal's evian®SPA is a 1,700m² facility. It captures the very essence of refinement and revitalisation, inspired by the miraculous water cycle found in nature. In the same way the hotel draws on all the goodness of its natural setting to imbue its guests with a serene way of living, the evian®SPA is an ode to that very nature: the omnipresence of water, the plant life and the

local mountain rock... Each one is an invitation to experience revitalisation.

The evian®SPA concept came into being in 2012. Today, it can be found at five iconic destinations around the world. The spa at Hôtel Royal is the first in Europe.

Water has always been central to well-being, providing the hydration needed for good health.

This is the belief on which evian®SPA has founded its concept, based on the water cycle present in nature. Four main dimensions form the cornerstone of the customer experience, with each one linked to a specific benefit:

- CELESTIAL Birth: The birth of water from the clouds, rain and snow
- MINERAL Infiltration: The natural infiltration of water into the mountains;
- PRECIOUS Reserves: Water remains underground for 15 years to obtain its balanced composition:
- VITALIZING Spring: The place where the water bursts forth.

evian®SPA provides its visitors with a comprehensive and immersive experience. With six individual treatment rooms and two further rooms for couples massages, every detail echoes the never-changing cycle of water. The treatment rooms afford views of nature, both through the windows and the gigantic photographs of the Alpine landscape. Guests are guaranteed an immersive experience in a soothing, enveloping atmosphere, at one with nature.

On their arrival, they are welcomed into an arched sanctuary with a film retracing the never-changing cycle of water. A sensory world in which nature, sounds and the elements are omnipresent, encouraging guests to let go, even before the wellness ritual begins.

The communal areas are an integral part of the experience. Water is given pride of place, in all shapes, forms and temperatures. From the outdoor hydro-circuit to the snow room, from the cold pool to the traditional sauna and steam room, and from the indoor pool to the aqua bar, water is everywhere... Even beyond the walls of the spa with the view of Lake Geneva. The 47-acre grounds add to the renewed feeling of well-being.
